Encourages and rewards commercial and industrial customers to reduce their load with a new AMR program.



SMLD's Guidance With RECs And Solar

The SMLD will facilitate the acquisition of RECs (renewable energy credits) for solar installations.



Waiver Of Fees For Solar Installations

A program whereby the SMLD waives our installation fees and the Town Of Sterling waives the electrical inspection and building permit fees for small residential solar installations.



Mass Energy's Heating Oil Alliance Program

A membership organization that operates like a co-op for any household who wants to save on heating costs.



SMLD Wind

SMLD has developed a by-law for wind development throughout the Town of Sterling.

For electric vehicles and distributed generation.

A voluntary program that costs 1.5 cents per kWh on each monthly bill. Proceeds go towards the SMLD's efforts to promote and maintain the purchase of power from hydroelectric and other renewable energy resources.
